## What I learned today:

### Bible: Mark 16:1-8

Jesus was praying in the garden when one of his close friends, Judas, betrayed him by leading soldiers to Jesus to arrest him. How awful! But Jesus knew that he was going to be betrayed, and he still went to the garden anyway. Then Jesus was nailed to a cross, and he died. That's even more awful! But Jesus knew he would be nailed to a cross, and he was still willing to go through with it. Then, three days later, several women who had been followers of Jesus went to visit his tomb. Imagine how surprised they were to find the tomb empty! Jesus came back to life so that we can live with him forever if we believe in him. How amazing!

**Key Verse:** People who believe in Jesus will live forever (adapted from John 11:25).

**Bible Point:** Jesus is alive.



### Always Remember

Don't forget to thank Jesus for what he did for us! Each day this week, begin your dinner prayer by thanking Jesus for dying for us and for rising from the dead so we can live with him in heaven. Then, during dinner, think of someone your family can tell about Jesus. Practice what you'll say to that person—then follow through!
