My Relationship With Jesus

Daily Challenge

Choose a way you'll grow in your relationship this week with Jesus:

BIBLE FOCUS (THE BASICS)

Suddenly, the sky became dark. After six hours on the cross, Jesus died. People had been making fun of him and teasing him the whole time he was dying, but when he died, a centurion soldier said, "Surely this man was the Son of God!" He knew then who Jesus really was!

Three days later when some of his friends went to Jesus' tomb to anoint his body, they were shocked to find that Jesus wasn't there. When they reached the tomb, the stone had been rolled away and a man dressed in a white robe was sitting there. He said, "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here."

Jesus kept his promise that he would rise from the dead after three days! He had power over death! And because Jesus lives, we can have eternal life! Isn't it great that Jesus is more powerful than death?

Key Verse: "Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies'" (John 11:25).

Bible Point: Jesus is alive.

Have each person take a piece and talk about how it relates to Jesus being alive. Maybe a candy egg reminds them of Jesus coming back to life. Or a miniature candy bar looks like the layers of the earth where Jesus was buried. Close by praying together, thanking Jesus for being alive.
