Q & A

How do I apply? Complete the application at www.ndcbf.org/internship.

How long is the internship? Internships are scheduled for the Fall (August - December), Spring (January - May) or Summer (June – July) semester.

How early can I apply? Applications can be submitted at any time. Please specify the semester and year you would like to serve.

Is this a paid internship position? At this time, there are no paid internships.

Do I have to be a member of your church? No, although we do require you to review 'Our Belief' at www.ndcbf.org.

Do I have to be a student? All interns must be enrolled in an accredited College or University.

Is there an age limit? All interns must be 18 years or older. We will consider individuals younger than 18 on an exception basis.

How soon will I be notified of acceptance?

Once you have submitted your application, you will be contacted within 7-10 business days for an intern interview. Selections will be made 2 weeks prior to the Fall, Spring or Summer class begin date.

What will my schedule look like?

The internship schedule is flexible and we will try to work around your school and/or personal commitments. Some schedules are however; based on the area of service for the internship and the hours required by your class program.

What happens at the end of my internship?
