13. And behold, two of them were going that very day to a village named Emmaus, which was about seven miles from Jerusalem. 14. When they were at the tomb early in the morning, 23. and did not find His body, they came, saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said that He was alive.

24. "Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just exactly as the women also had said; but Him they did not see." 25. And He said to them, "O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! 26 "Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?" 27 Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.

44. Now He said to them, "These are My words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things which are written about Me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled." 45. Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, 46 and He said to them, "Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day...
